Player Matchups will be completely random. Any skill level player can play provided the player has played at least 5 PACS 8 Ball matches last and/or this session. Players must also be in good standing with the league office. PACS reserves the right to deny anyone from entering this tournament for any reason.

Players will begin the tournament at whatever their assigned handicap is as of the time they pay their entry fee. There is a chance that a player will play at a higher HC than their current paper HC. This tournament will be a factor in determining a players' future handicap. Any player who is less than a "7.5" and goes undefeated through the "winners' side" of the bracket will have .5 added to their handicap for their finals match(s).
