PROJECTED TEAM PAYOUTS THIS SESSION IS \$7600 (14 WEEK SESSION)

At the end of the session, the player with the most break and runs will get \$5 per break and run. In the event of a tie, the players will split the money evenly (Ex. 2 players are tied with 8 each at the end of the session. Each player will receive \$20).

Players from this division must play at least 6 matches to qualify for the PACS 14th Invitational. To qualify for MVP, players must play at least 8 matches. Team to win this Monday division will receive a projected \$ 400 to be awarded at the PACS 14th Invitational. Teams may not recycle players the last 2 weeks of the session. New players may not be added the last 3 weeks of the session.

MVPs of this division will receive \$ 30 each.

MVP Rules - 8 total matches required to win MVP (This division, this session)

Best Match win percentage will determine the winner. In the event of a tie, tiebreakers are as follows...

- 1) Most matches played
- 2) Head to head
- 3) Strength of schedule (Average of skill levels of opponents)
- 4) Rack (Game) percentage.

There will be one (1) MVP from each of the following skill level categories.....2/3 S/L, 4/5 S/L, and 6/7/8 S/L
Qualification S/L is where you played a majority of your matches, lower if tied

MVP Standings (Must have at least 7 Matches to be listed)

Number in parenthesis is number of matches played under current Skill Level Category

Top 3 teams from this division will receive automatic byes into the weekend of the Invitational. Teams seeded 4 and 5 will have "Play-in" Matches on the first Monday following the end of the session.

In the event of 2 or more teams in the same division having the identical win/loss percentage, tiebreakers will be as follows..

If two (2) teams...

1. Best win/loss match percentage in head to head.

2. Best margin of victory total record in head to head.

Example... 2 teams played each other twice and are 5-5 overall. The team with the best overall margin of victory in all 10 matches played would win the tiebreaker.

3. Team that won the LAST head to head meeting. Example...

Two teams played each other twice during the session. Tiebreakers 1 and 2 (above) have not produced a winner yet. The last tiebreaker would go to the team that won at least 3 individual matches in the LAST head to head meeting between the two teams.

If three (3) or more teams...

1. Best win/loss match percentages between only those teams. Example.. Team A, B, and C each played each other one time. Scores were as follows..

Team A wins 3-2 over Team B

Team A wins 3-2 over Team C

Team C wins 5-0 over Team B

Team C would win tiebreaker because of overall 7-3 record.

2. Best margin of victory total record in head to head among the teams that are tied

(see above in tiebreakers between 2 teams)

Once a "winner" is determined in a situation whereby three or more teams are tied, the process is repeated to determine the next highest seeded team (if necessary). If this is necessary, the results of any matches with the " winner" are discarded in the next round of tiebreakers.

For every team that does not qualify for postseason but also doesn't forfeit any individual matches during the regular session, they will be eligible for a random drawing for \$400 at the end of the session
Teams must also have all past dues and tournament entries paid to be eligible.
